

UPPER ARLINGTON CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT
STUDENT TRANSPORTATION REIMBURSEMENT

State law provides that: "Where it is impractical to transport a pupil by school conveyance, a board of education may offer payment, in lieu of providing such transportation in accordance with section 3327.02 of the Revised Code."

The Upper Arlington Board of Education, after examination of possible school bus routes, time schedules, student residence, available school buses and other related information; and, upon establishing that the below listed pupil is eligible to receive transportation by law and board policy, will declare by Board resolution that such services by school bus is "impractical." The Board, therefore, agrees to pay the parent or guardian of said pupil in lieu of providing such service an amount which shall not exceed the state average cost per pupil in the state the preceding year.
