


HASTINGS MIDDLE SCHOOL

BUILDING TEAM SURVEY FEEDBACK

MAY 2016

District leaders asked the members of each school's building team to take a brief online survey in which they selected their preferred option for that school building. Twenty-four members of the Hastings Middle School building team responded. All results and comments are included in the compiled totals and feedback.

HASTINGS MIDDLE SCHOOL COMMENTS

- We really need to set up for our future by creating the best learning environment for our kids.
- For Hastings, I think either a rebuild or renovate option could work, pending design. I do not like either design site diagram as-is.
- I am in favor of the rebuild option because I feel that renovating a building (to the extent proposed) of this age will be problematic. The amount of time and inconvenience is the same regardless of the option and that we will be better able to design a building that will move us into the next half century with a rebuild. I have spoken to quite a few people in the building and our consensus is rebuild.
- Rebuild out of these 3 options is the only one that makes sense. However, it is difficult to make a logical decision given I have no idea what the plans are for the other buildings. We can't rebuild them all so if it came down to prioritization of which buildings get rebuilt vs renovated this could change my response. The HS being rebuilt should be the main priority out of all of them.
- I am a strong supporter of the need for UACS to address the facilities issue and feel it is vital to the district and the community. I do not think the district

considered all available options for addressing its facilities needs. I also do not think the decision for individual buildings and the characterization of the property taxes shown above is indicative of what the investment costs will be for homeowners. This decision will be made for all buildings not individual buildings, as the characterization seems to suggest. While individual building team members probably understand this, please don't take that approach with the community as its purpose may be misinterpreted and not in a good way.

- None. Neither option should be considered at this time as both middle have had extensive renovations in the last several years.
- Rebuilding makes sense when only looking at one building like this survey has but my answer could change drastically when looking at all the options at once for all buildings. For example the HS being rebuilt is more of a priority than Hastings thus my answer would change and would probably be renovate if I had to view this big picture.
